

These are instructions to power down an alarm panel or silence the panel beeping for a few hours. You can also provide this web address to view the instructions and videos: https://smarthome.calstate.aaa.com/upgrade-diy/

- Powering down the panel will disable the beeping indefinitely until it can be reactivated
- **Silencing the panel** is a temporary solution that will require the Member to silence the panel every few hours until Tech Support can assist the Member with a follow up call

# FIRST ALERT HONEYWELL VISTA 10P/15P/20P



<u>Power Down:</u> Locate metal or plastic control panel (usually in a closet or pantry). Have the member locate the large plug (transformer) and disconnect from the outlet. Instruct the member to open the panel and disconnect the 12V battery sitting on the bottom shelf of the panel.

Silence Panel: Have the Member enter their FOUR DIGIT CODE on the keypad and then press 1

CLEAR TROUBLE OR ALARM MEMORY: FOUR DIGIT CODE  $\rightarrow$  1 $\rightarrow$ FOUR DIGIT CODE  $\rightarrow$ 1

# **HONEYWELL LYNX/LYNX PLUS**



**POWER DOWN:** Tools needed: (1) small or medium flathead screwdriver.

- Direct the member to locate the plug (transformer) and disconnect it from the wall outlet
- Have the member open the keypad using the screwdriver. There are (2) tabs at the top of the panel. Gently use the screwdriver to depress the tabs and the front of the keypad will swing down.
- Instruct member to unplug the battery pack connector from the circuit board.

<u>SILENCE TROUBLE:</u> Have the Member enter their FOUR DIGIT CODE on the keypad and then press the OFF button.

<u>CLEAR ALARM/TROUBLE MEMORY:</u> Have the Member enter the FOUR DIGIT CODE on the keypad and then press the OFF button, twice in a row

**POWER DOWN:** Tools needed: (1) small or medium flathead screwdriver.

- Direct the member to locate the plug (transformer) and disconnect it from the wall outlet
- Have the member open the keypad using the screwdriver. There are (2) tabs at the top of the panel. Gently use the screwdriver to depress the tabs and the front of the keypad will swing down.
- Instruct the member to unplug the battery pack connector from the circuit board.

<u>SILENCE TROUBLE:</u> press SECURITY, then press DISARM, then enter FOUR DIGIT CODE <u>CLEAR TROUBLE OR ALARM MEMORY:</u> PRESS DISARM>FOUR DIGIT CODE

**POWER DOWN:** Tools needed: (1) Flathead screwdriver and (1) medium Philips screwdriver

- Locate power adapter (transformer) and unplug from outlet
- Open the front face of the panel
- Use the Philips screwdriver to open the white battery housing on the rear of the wall mount.
- Disconnect the battery.

POWER DOWN: Tools needed: (1) small Philips screwdriver

- Locate power adapter (transformer) and unplug from outlet
- Remove the small screw located in the top middle of the keypad
- Depress the two small tabs on either side of the screw socket and the front face will swing forward
- Battery is located inside the face of the panel. Have member gently pull apart the 2 white clips holding the



battery in, remove the battery, and disconnect the wires.

**POWER DOWN INSTRUCTIONS:** Locate and unplug the power adapter from the electrical outlet.

- Using the notch in the lower right corner, remove the frame from the panel.
- Pull open the panel from the top it will swing open
- Disconnect the battery connector from its socket

#### \*PUSH THE HOME BUTTON UNDER THE SCREEN BEFORE & AFTER STARTING ANY COMMAND SEQUENCE

POWER DOWN INSTRUCTIONS: Tools needed: (1) Philips-head screwdriver, (1) flathead screwdriver

- Locate and unplug power adapter (transformer) from the outlet
- Remove the small Philips screw at the top center of the panel
- Push the flathead screwdriver into the two (2) tabs to either side of the screw to open the panel face
- Disconnect the battery pack connector


<u>SILENCE TROUBLE/TAMPER:</u> Press OK to acknowledge system alert **AND** Press **SECURITY**, then press **STATUS**, then press **SILENCE**, then press **BACK**, then press **BACK** 

**CLEAR TROUBLE OR ALARM MEMORY:** PRESS CLEAR ALARM MEMORY→ PRESS OK

<u>POWER DOWN INSTRUCTIONS:</u> Locate metal or plastic control panel (usually in a closet or pantry). Have the member locate the large plug (transformer) and disconnect from the outlet. Instruct the member to open the panel and disconnect the 12V battery sitting on the bottom shelf of the panel.

SILENCE TROUBLE: PRESS COMMAND, then press 4

<u>CLEAR TROUBLE OR ALARM MEMORY:</u> PRESS COMMAND + 4, OR FOUR DIGIT USER CODE + ENTER

**SILENCE TROUBLE:** ENTER FOUR DIGIT CODE

<u>CLEAR TROUBLE OR ALARM MEMORY:</u> PRESS COMMAND 2 TIMES, PRESS BUTTON UNDER YES, ENTER FOUR DIGIT CODE, (SENSOR RESET IS DISPLAYED) PRESS TOP RIGHT BUTTON

#### **POWER DOWN INSTRUCTIONS:** Locate the plug and disconnect it from the outlet

- Press the button on the bottom of the dialer (where the phone line is connected)
- Open the unit from the bottom
- Gently remove the single battery from its connectors on the circuit board
